

Health policies and measures for the 24th TCI Global International Conference

Being a socially responsible organization and realizing the increased interest of the audience in the resumption of business meetings, the Innokam Association, the organizer of the event seeks to ensure maximum safety at the site for both participants and visitors of the event.

The 24th TCI Global International Conference (hereinafter referred to as the Conference) will be organized and held in accordance with the regulations of federal and regional legislation regarding the holding of congress, exhibition, and communication events on the date of the Conference.

Social distancing

- We carefully plan the arrival, access, and registration procedures for exhibitors, contractors, and visitors. As far as possible, this process will be non-contact with monitoring the number of visitors and participants using an electronic attendance counting system.
- Where appropriate, considering the provision of the necessary entry process, we will increase the number of entrances to the event site.
- The systems and facilities of the Conference Site Service Center will be reviewed and protected by screens/barriers where possible. Social distancing protocols regarding personnel of different functional groups (organizers, Convention Bureau staff, employees of service organizations, technical personnel, etc.) both during the period of assembly/disassembly work (for technical personnel - considering the safety requirements) and during the event will be followed. The situation is constantly monitored and you will be informed about any other necessary systems of precautionary measures in advance of the Conference.

Hygiene

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available in regular restrooms, building entrances and exits, food service outlets, and additional hand hygiene products will be provided at venues for business events, hall entrances, and other high-traffic areas.
- General cleaning services will be expanded at the Conference venue, and all surfaces (door handles, tables, elevator buttons, escalators, etc.) will be regularly cleaned using special disinfectant solutions.
- Before the opening of the Conference venues, wet cleaning will be carried out using disinfectants with virucidal activity.
- The intensity of cleaning services for the Conference area will be increased, and disinfection will be carried out several times a day.

Personal protective equipment

- All categories of people will be allowed to the event site only with a face mask (respirator) on; when visiting an exhibition event, in addition to a mask, gloves will be required.

- Individuals in the territory of the Conference without personal protective equipment and neglecting the rules of hygiene will be warned by the responsible staff. If the behavior recurs, the person will be denied access to the Conference venue.
- Used masks (respirators) and gloves of personnel, participants, visitors of the event will be collected in plastic bags with subsequent disposal as solid waste.

General measures

- The staff, exhibitors, participants, and visitors of the Conference will be informed by preliminary mailing, posting text, audio/visual information on the event's websites, at the entrance lobbies, in the information zones, including using digital posters, about the need to comply with preventing the spread of COVID-19 infection.
- Body temperature screening will be conducted for all the visitors at the entrances to the Conference area.
- An ambulance team will be available on the Conference site to provide emergency medical care.
- In case of construction at the Conference site, the width of the passage will be kept at least 3 meters.
- Daily wet cleaning of staff areas (headquarters, office, service premises) and common areas (recreation rooms for employees, lobbies, information, food service, business communication, and exhibition areas, restrooms) will be carried out using virucidal disinfectants.
- Transport services provided by the organizer or its representatives will be used in compliance with the measures of local legislation regarding passenger transportation.

Air

- Whenever possible, equipment for air disinfection, permitted for use in the presence of people, will be used in Conference rooms and other occupied rooms.
- The intervals between sessions in the halls will be set at least 15 minutes for ventilation and disinfection of contact surfaces.
- The event organizers will keep in touch at the venues to ensure the best ventilation efficiency in the Conference rooms with the air recovery off.

Personal responsibility

- To speed up the registration process at the Conference site, we ask all participants to print out the entrance ticket in advance. Online registration and ticket purchase will be open on the official website of the Conference, tci2021.org.
- Dear participants, we ask you to take care of arranging personal insurance for the duration of the Conference in advance.
- All participants arriving at the Conference site are encouraged to bring their own protective equipment. However, in case of a shortage of personal protective equipment or their loss/damage, it will be possible to purchase them at the Conference site.
