11:00 – 17:00	<p>1. Smart City. Innopolis is a new city in the Republic of Tatarstan (founded in 2012), located at the confluence of two rivers - the Volga and Sviyaga. The first Russian city for IT professionals. The development of the Innopolis master plan was led by Liu Tai Ker, general planner for the redevelopment department of Singapore, the benchmark for most modern cities in the world. Innopolis is a global project, unique in that one site provides conditions for comfortable living and work of young IT professionals and their families, for whom houses, kindergartens, schools, universities, health and sports facilities have been built. 	<p>2. Oil and chemistry. The Republic of Tatarstan is one of the leading regions of the petrochemical complex in Russia. The republic produces about 40% of synthetic rubbers, more than 50% of truck tires, 15% of passenger car tires and plastics,</p>		

13% of detergents produced in the country. Over the past 20 years, all enterprises of the petrochemical complex have been completely modernized, capacities have been created for the production of a wide range of plastic products for industrial and domestic use, and a consortium of independent oil producing companies has been created. High results were achieved by the planned policy of the regional authorities to increase the depth of processing of raw materials. The key industrial event of the region was the integration and cooperation of oil producing, oil refining, chemical and petrochemical enterprises of the republic into a single complex (cluster).
